

## **IDEAS AND SUGGESTIONS FOR SERVICES**

- Acknowledge the traditional owners of the land. (Check with your NATSIAC delegate as listed) or you may say,

“We acknowledge the traditional owners of this land and we pay our respects to their ancestors and to their Dreaming.”

- Have a red, black and yellow Sunday. The congregation all comes with something in the colours.
- Congregation wears ribbons of red, black and yellow. Could be supplied at the door for all the congregation to wear as they receive their pew sheets and books.
- Include Aboriginal people in the service as readers, speakers, musicians, dancers, etc
- Use Australian elements in the service such as Eucalyptus oil, tea tree oil, gum leaves and Indigenous symbols and materials around the altar.
- Use an Indigenous prayer during service.
- Use a local Aboriginal story as a reading for the day.
- Use Aboriginal clipart on pew sheets etc,
- Use our Covenant Presentation as a reflection during the service.
